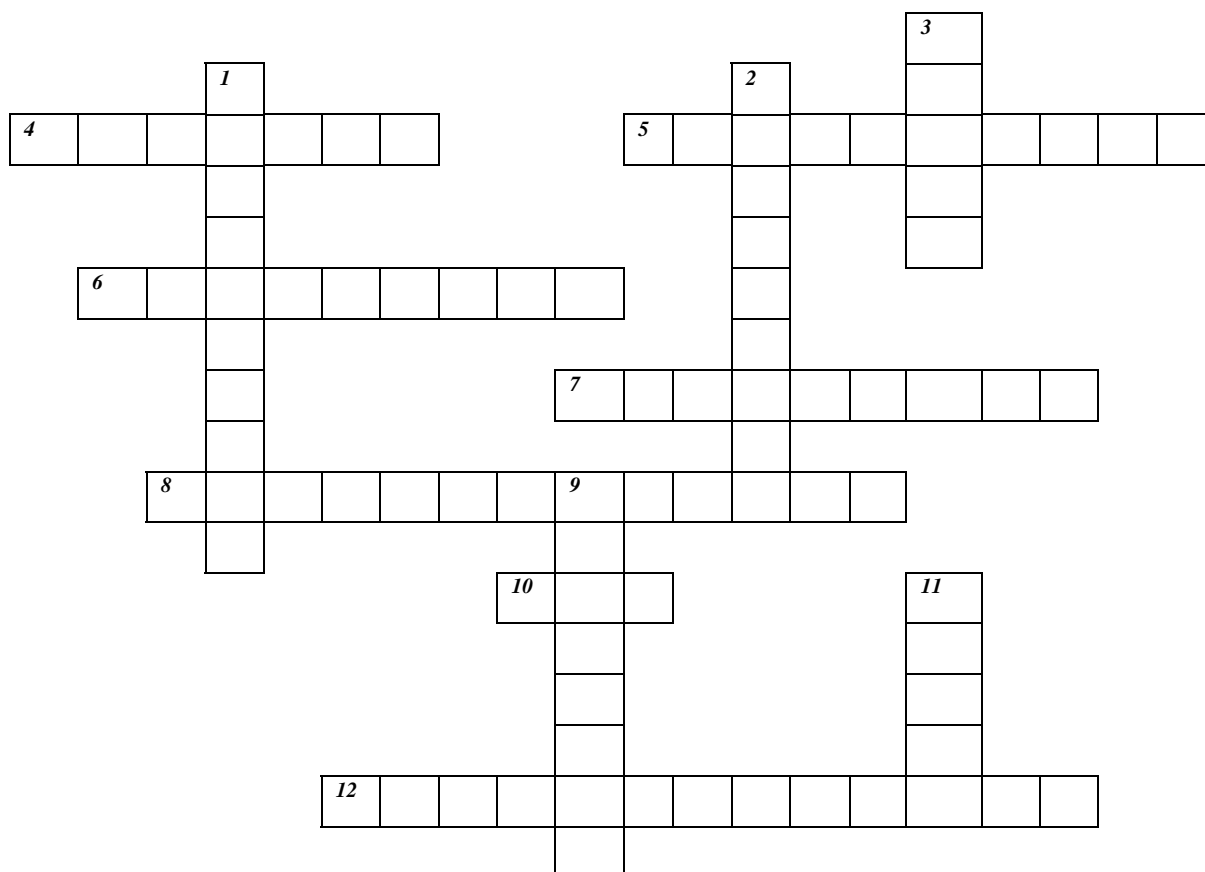


The Great Woodland Adventure Puzzler
